



It was a nice Sunday morning. Birds were singing their songs while people were sleeping.


Suddenly people's dogs started to bark as if something was coming towards them.



From Alex's house you could see a medium black bear coming.


It was the bear that the dogs were barking at.

He saw Benny with a rifle behind Leo's house.


Pierre went outside to help Benny.



Jimmy's daughter went outside to get some water. She didn't know about the bear behind Francis' house.


As she opened the water tap from the tank she saw a black bear walking towards her.

Benny ran back to his house to get a knife.




Benny followed the boys to where they put the bear.
